PLAN YOUR TRIP

BY TRAIN

Located 1 mile away from the arena, the nearest train station is Sheffield Rail Station. Sheffield Rail Station is served by frequent and direct EMR services from London St Pancras (2h 38m) and Liverpool Lime Street in (1h 48m), as well as many other cities across the country. BY BUS

From Pond Street/Paternoster Row, take bus number 18 or 252 to Bramall Lane. This journey takes approximately 7 minutes, with buses running every 20 minutes.

BY TRAM

To reach the stadium by tram, take the blue or purple line from the city centre to Granville Road/ The Sheffield College tram stop. From here, Bramall Lane is 0.8 miles away.

WALKING ROUTE

From Sheffield Rail Station, Bramall Lane is approximately a 15 minute walk. Please see the map, or use our journey planner, to plan your route.

BY CAR

The postcode to use for Bramall Lane is **S2 4SU.** For directions by car, use the RLWC2021 journey planner.

CAR PARKING

There will be no parking at Bramall Lane, on-street parking in the surrounding area is very limited. While no parking is available at Bramall Lane Stadium, there are many local car parks which operate on a first come first served basis. Keep in mind that car park charges will apply.

The car parks at Eyre Street, Arundel Street and Matilda street, offer over 700 spaces between them and all three are within a 10-minute walk of the venue.
