PLAN YOUR TRIP

BY TRAIN

Located 4.5 miles away from the station, the nearest national train station is Newcastle Central Station. Newcastle Central Station is located on the East Coast Mainline, with high-speed inter-city services southbound every half an hour from London.

BY BUS

From Eldon Square, take bus number X47 to Kingston Park. This journey takes approximately 24 minutes, with buses leaving Eldon Square every 15 minutes.

METRO

To reach the stadium by metro, take the green line from Newcastle Central Station to Kingston Park Metro. This journey takes approximately 19 minutes. From here, the stadium is a 10 minute walk away.

WALKING ROUTE

The walk from Kingston Park Metro station takes approximately ten minutes. Please see the map, or use our journey planner, to plan your route.

BY CAR

The postcode to use for Kingston Park is **NE13 8AF**, however for directions by car, use the RLWC2021 journey planner.

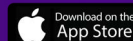

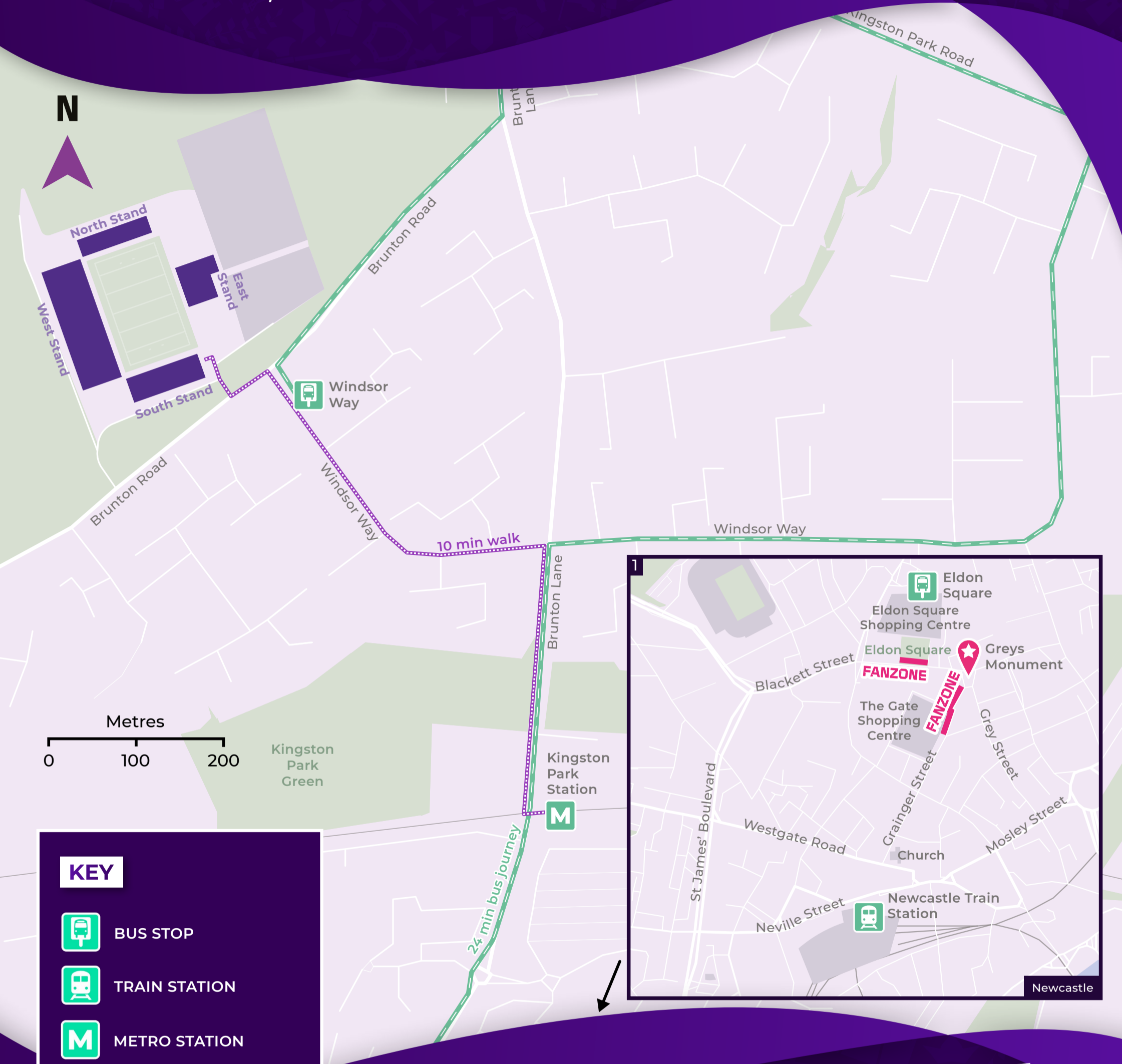
